WHEREAS, *The Extremes of Virginia* also examines the hopes, aspirations, values, and expectations of the people who live and work in Southwest Virginia, Southside Virginia, and the Eastern Shore of Virginia, and

WHEREAS, former Governor Gerald L. Baliles, has called *The Extremes of Virginia* "required reading for legislators and governors" and "a useful contribution to our understanding that the Commonwealth is not common when nearly two thirds of its geography is rural, poor and unknown"; and
