5 WHEREAS, Francena McCorory of Hampton proudly represented the United States and the
7 Commonwealth at the Games of the XXXI Olympiad in Rio de Janeiro in 2016, winning a gold medal
8 as a member of the women's 4x400-meter relay team; and

9 WHEREAS, born in California, Francena McCorory grew up in Hampton, where she graduated from
10 Bethel High School and Hampton University; she won National Collegiate Athletic Association titles for
11 the indoor 400-meter race in 2009 and the indoor and outdoor 400-meter races in 2010; and

WHEREAS, Francena McCorory holds the American record for the women's indoor 400-meter racewith a time of 50.54 seconds and has earned six medals in world championship races; and

WHEREAS, at the 2016 Olympic Games, Francena McCorory helped lead the women's 4x400-meter relay team to a winning time of 3:19.06; she previously earned a gold medal in the same event at the 2012 Olympic Games: and

WHÉRÉAS, throughout her track and field career, and during the Olympic Games in particular,
Francena McCorory has enjoyed the ardent support of her family, friends, coaches, and members of the
Hampton community; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly hereby
 21 commend Francena McCorory on winning a gold medal in the women's 4x400-meter relay at the Games
 22 of the XXXI Olympiad; and, be it

 outstanding achievements as a member of Team USA.
