3. Committee: Health, Welfare and Institutions

4. Title: Voluntary listing of certain family day homes.

5. Summary: Provides for the voluntary inclusion of certain family day homes that provide care for fewer than five children, exclusive of the provider's own children and any children that reside in the home, on a list of family day homes maintained by the Department of Social Services (the Department). Such voluntary listing replaces the voluntary registration of family day homes with the Department under current law.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Social Services is currently responsible for the maintenance of the list of family day homes classified as voluntarily registered family day homes. Under this bill, the option for family day homes serving fewer than five children to apply for voluntary registration is removed and is replaced by an option for those family day homes to apply to be voluntarily included on a list of family day homes maintained by the Department. The maintenance of this list would not require additional appropriation.

The Department of Social Services maintains that this legislation is out of compliance with the federal Child Care and Development Block Grant (CCDBG) Act of 2014. If this bill is found to be out of compliance with the CCDBG Act upon further review by the federal agency administering the grant funding, the penalty will be equal to five percent of Virginia's Child Care and Development Fund (CCDF) discretionary fund grant award, which equaled \$2.3 million in FY 2015.
