Summary:** Modifies the requirement for sight and hearing testing of public school students to exclude any student who has any defect of vision or hearing or disease of the eyes or ears that requires the use of a corrective or supplemental device as set forth in the student's Individualized Education Program.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** There is not any anticipated state fiscal impact resulting from the provisions of this bill. Testing of public school students' sight and hearing is conducted by school nurses within the local school divisions.
