3. Committee: Passed Both Houses

4. Title: Farm use vehicles; imposes a \$250 fine for failing to comply with restrictions for use on highway.

5. Summary: Imposes a \$250 fine for second and subsequent violations of failing to comply with the restrictions for the use of farm use vehicles on the highway. Current law allows for a fine of up to \$250 regardless of number of violations.

8. Fiscal Implications: This legislation could have a possible revenue impact due to disallowing fines less than \$250 for second and subsequent violations, but it is impossible to determine the extent of the impact at this time.
