**4. Title:** Child support orders; special needs trust; ABLE savings trust account.

**5. Summary:** Child support orders; special needs trust; ABLE savings trust account. Provides that, upon the request of either party, a court may order that support payments be made to a special needs trust or an ABLE savings trust account.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** According to the Office of the Executive Secretary of the Supreme Court (OES), the proposed legislation is not expected to have a material fiscal impact on the court system.

Special needs trust or Achieving a Better Life Experience (ABLE) savings trust accounts are used to hold funds so families may provide for individuals with disabilities without negatively impacting the federal government benefits received by those individuals. According to the Department of Social Services (DSS), the proposed legislation would not create a fiscal impact on the agency.
