4. Title: Special conservators of the peace

5. Summary:

Current law requires that a special conservator of the peace be covered by liability insurance or self-insurance in an amount and with coverage fixed by the Criminal Justice Services Board. The board's regulations require that such insurance be professional liability insurance.

The proposed legislation would amend the requirements to require a special conservator of the peace to be covered by:

- Personal injury liability insurance;
- Property damage liability insurance; and
- Miscellaneous casualty insurance, which includes professional liability insurance that provides coverage for any activity within the scope of the duties of a special conservator of the peace;

or by self-insurance, in an amount and with coverage as fixed by the board.

8. Fiscal Implications: The proposed legislation would have no fiscal impact on the Department of Criminal Justice Services, which administers regulations of special conservators of the peace.
