4. Title: Public contracts; civil liability; gender identity; sexual orientation.

5. Summary: Public contracts; civil liability; gender identity; sexual orientation. Prohibits agencies of the Commonwealth and other public bodies from requiring any contractor entering into a public contract to agree to additional nondiscrimination provisions with respect to gender identity or sexual orientation. The bill also provides civil immunity for any business or nonprofit organization that does not provide any benefit or accommodation with respect to gender identity or sexual orientation.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate, see Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Attorney General and Department of Law and the Department of General Services indicate that they will not be fiscally impacted by the bill.

The bill could put Virginia practices in conflict with practices required by federal grants that could potentially lead to disallowances.
