1.	Title:	Joint Commission on Administrative Rules; periodic review of regulatory exemptions from the Administrative Process Act.						
5.	<b>Summary:</b> The enrolled bill requires the Joint Commission on Administrative Rules, beginning November 1, 2017, to conduct a review of the regulatory exemptions authorized by the Administrative Process Act (APA). The bill also requires agencies having APA exemptions, beginning August 1, 2017, to submit a written report to the Joint Commission on Administrative Rules, and a summary report every two years thereafter. The bill provides that in the event that an agency having an exemption fails to submit the report required, the Joint Commission on Administrative Rules shall recommend to the Governor and the General Assembly that such agency's exemption be discontinued. The bill also requires general notice of the provisions of this requirement to be posted on the Virginia Regulatory Town Hall and published in the Virginia Register of Regulations by the Joint Commission on Administrative Rules to advise agencies of their obligations under the bill.
