3. Committee: Transportation

4. Title: Issuance of licenses, permits, and special identification cards; requirements.

5. Summary: This bill allows the issuance of a temporary driver's license, permit, or special identification card to an applicant presenting valid documentary evidence that a federal court or federal agency having jurisdiction over immigration has authorized the applicant to be in the United States for a period of at least 30 days from the date of application.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item #8.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill is expected to have a minimal impact, with the affected population estimated at only 6,000 people across the Commonwealth. Currently, the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) services over 6 million license and identification card holders, so the increase from this bill would very minor. In addition, there would be minimal impact to DMV automated systems to make table changes that would allow individuals with authorization from the federal government to remain in the United States to obtain temporary driver's licenses, permits, and special identification cards. The DMV web page and publications, forms, and procedures would also have to be modified.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of Motor Vehicles.

11. Other Comments: This bill is a companion to HB2020.
