Summary: Provides that a clerk of a circuit court that has established an electronic filing ystem for land records may charge a fee not to exceed \$5 per instrument for every land ecord filed by paper.

Fiscal Implications: The proposed legislation would eliminate the \$5 per instrument fee ome circuit court clerks assess for electronically filing land records and assesses the \$5 fee o persons who file paper records in clerk offices where electronic filing is available. This is a ocal fee that is assessed and maintained in a local non-reverting fund. Circuit court clerks use the funding to make electronic filing of land records available online.
According to Compensation Board, the proposed legislation has no fiscal impact on state general fund revenues.
