3. **Committee:** Education and Health

4. **Title:** School boards; procedures; sexually explicit instructional materials or related academic activities.

5. **Summary:** Requires each school board's procedures for handling controversial instructional materials to include procedures for (i) notifying, at the beginning of each school year and at such times as an additional notification may become necessary during the school year, the parent of any student enrolled in a course in which the instructional materials or related academic activities may include sexually explicit content or the potential for such sexually explicit content in such course and (ii) providing, as a replacement for instructional materials or related academic activities that include sexually explicit content, nonexplicit instructional materials or related academic activities to any student whose parent so requests. Clarifies that "sexually explicit content" means content that involves any criminal sexual assault defined and punishable as a felony.
