4. Title: Public charter school applications and charter agreements; review by the Board of Education.

5. Summary: Permits the Board of Education to remand to a school board for further consideration any denied public charter school application or revoked or nonrenewed charter agreement in any school division in which at least half of the schools receive funding pursuant to Title I, Part A of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965, as amended, upon finding insufficient rationale for such denial, revocation, or nonrenewal based on documentation submitted to the Board by the school board.
