4. Title: Report of law-enforcement officer involved in accident.

5. Summary: This bill provides that any law-enforcement officer who is listed as a driver in a motor vehicle accident report submitted to the Department of Motor Vehicles will not have the accident listed on his driving record if he was driving a motor vehicle provided by a law-enforcement agency in the course of his employment and was engaged in law-enforcement activity at the time of such accident.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item #8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) does not anticipate a fiscal impact from this proposal. The legislation codifies an existing practice that DMV has performed administratively for many decades.
