3. Committee: House Committee on General Laws

4. Title: Alcoholic beverage control; spirits tastings by distiller licensee.

5. Summary: Allows distillery stores to provide ounce samples to persons to whom alcoholic beverages may be lawfully sold for on-premises consumption. If the sample is provided in a mixed beverage, the sample can be up to two ounces in size. In the case of spirit samples, there is no limit to the number of samples except at the discretion of the bartender.
