**2. Patron:** Stuart

**3. Committee:** Passed both Houses.

**4. Title:** Concealed handgun permits; sharing of information.

**5. Summary:** Prohibits sharing of information regarding Virginia concealed handgun permits in the Virginia Criminal Information Network with law enforcement in states that do not recognize a Virginia concealed handgun permit as valid in the state. The bill requires the Department of State Police to maintain and publish online a list of states that recognize a Virginia concealed handgun permit as valid in the state. The bill does not create a private cause of action.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Final. See below.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** According to the Department of State Police (Department), it has previously created such a list by conducting a survey of all states but the list would need to be updated on a regular basis. The previous survey was completed in three (3) months. As drafted, the proposed legislation has minimal impact on the Department's operation.
