- **3.** Committee: General Laws and Technology
- **4. Title:** Virginia Freedom of Information Act (FOIA); closed meeting violations; civil penalty.
- **5. Summary:** The bill provides that in addition to any penalties imposed under FOIA, if the court finds that a member of a public body voted to certify a closed meeting and at the time of such certification such certification constituted a departure from the requirements of FOIA, the court shall impose on all members voting to certify in their individual capacity, whether or not a writ of mandamus or injunctive relief is awarded, a civil penalty of \$500 each.
- 6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.
- 7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate.
- 8. Fiscal Implications: This expanded penalty that can be imposed related to public body proceedings is punishable by a civil penalty of \$500. However, it is unknown how often the offense will be incurred, so the fiscal impact cannot be determined. Civil penalty amounts imposed are paid into the State Literary Fund..
- **9.** Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: All public bodies whose members are required to vote to certify a closed meeting.
