4. Title: Alcoholic beverage control; walking tour permit.

5. Summary: Creates a new permit that allows tour companies guiding individuals for compensation on a walking tour to licensed retail establishments to collect as one fee from tour participants (i) the licensee's fee for the alcoholic beverages served as part of the tour, (ii) a fee for any food offered as part of the tour, and (iii) a fee for the walking tour service. The bill requires the tour company to remit to the licensee any fee collected for the alcoholic beverages served as part of the tour.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC), the proposed bill will have an indeterminate impact on the agency's licensing and enforcement operations. It is uncertain as to the number of licensees that will apply for this new permit; therefore, the fiscal impact cannot be determined at this time.
