4. Title: Adultery; civil penalty.

5. Summary: The bill reduces the penalty for adultery from a Class 4 misdemeanor to a civil penalty of not more than \$250.

8. Fiscal Implications: The bill is not expected to have a fiscal impact. A violation of the existing legislation is a Class 4 misdemeanor with a maximum fine up to \$250, which is deposited into the Literary Fund. The proposal makes the violation a civil penalty with the same fine deposited to the Literary Fund.
