3. Committee: Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources

4. Title: State Water Control Board; stormwater management programs, regulations, professional license.

5. Summary: Directs the State Water Control Board to adopt regulations requiring that all plan elements, specifications, or calculations whose preparation requires a license in engineering, architecture, soil science, or a related profession be signed and sealed by a licensed professional. The bill requires the regulations to be effective no later than July 1, 2018, and exempts them from certain provisions of the Administrative Process Act (§ 2.2-4000 et seq.).

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that any impact that may be incurred in developing regulations can be absorbed within existing resources.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of Environmental Quality, State Water Control Board, localities.
