3. Committee: Courts of Justice

4. Title: Termination of parental rights; manufacture of methamphetamine.

5. Summary: Includes in the definition of "severe abuse" knowingly allowing a child to be present during the manufacture or attempted manufacture of methamphetamine. Severe abuse is included in the definition of "aggravated circumstances"; under current law, a finding of aggravated circumstances can lead to termination of parental rights under certain conditions.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill adds to the existing definition of severe abuse used in Termination of Parental Rights proceedings held in Juvenile and Domestic Relations Courts. There is no fiscal impact.
