3. Committee: General Laws and Technology

4. Title: Board for Contractors; Class D registration; responsibility for contracting with unlicensed or unregistered person.

5. Summary: Provides an exemption from the regulation of contractors for work undertaken by a person providing construction, remodeling, repair, improvement, removal, or demolition valued at \$2,500 or less per project on behalf of a properly licensed contractor, with the exception of any construction services that require an individual license or certification. The bill also provides that any contractor who directly employs, or otherwise contracts with, a person who is not credentialed by the Board for Contractors for work requiring a credential shall be solely responsible for any monetary penalty or other sanction resulting from employing or contracting with a person who lacks the proper credential.
