4. Title: Public schools; possession of glucagon

5. Summary: Requires local school boards to adopt and implement policies for the possession and administration of glucagon in every school that one or more students with diabetes attend and requires the Board of Education to adopt and implement policies for the possession and administration of glucagon in every school for students with disabilities that one or more students with diabetes attend. The bill allows a school nurse, an employee of the school board, an employee of a local governing body, an employee of a local health department, or an employee of the school for students with disabilities who is authorized by a prescriber and trained in the administration of glucagon to any student diagnosed with diabetes believed to be suffering from or about to suffer from life-threatening hypoglycemia.
