- **4. Title:** Provide public notice of proposed tuition increase
- 5. Summary: This bill prohibits the governing board of a public institution of higher education from approving an increase in tuition or mandatory fees without first publishing in a prominent location on the institution's website a brief synopsis of the proposed increase including an explanation of the need for such an increase and the maximum potential amount of such an increase and notice of the date, time, and location of any vote on the increase at least 30 days in advance. This bill also requires a copy of the synopsis and the notice to be emailed to each student and that public comment be accepted at any hearing on the increase.

- 7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary (see Section 8)
- **8. Fiscal Implications:** It is anticipated that any costs associated with institutions complying with the requirements of the proposed legislation can be absorbed by them.
