- 7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Fiscal impact is indeterminate. See Item 8, below.
- **8. Fiscal Implications:** The fiscal impact is indeterminate, as it is unknown at this time what surplus material may become available from the General Assembly replacement project. This bill directs the net proceeds, less direct costs incurred by the Clerk of the Senate, Clerk of the House of Delegates, or the Department of General Services, from the sale of such property be appropriated to the Virginia Capitol Preservation Foundation, a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization. Pursuant to §2.2-1125, *Code of Virginia*, 50 percent of the net proceeds derived from the sale of surplus material originally purchased with general fund appropriation is distributed to the Conservation Resources Fund. This legislation would instead distribute the net proceeds to the Virginia Capitol Preservation Foundation.
