**2. Patron:** Favola

**3. Committee:** Education and Health

**4. Title:** Regulations governing hospitals; facilities performing abortions.

**5. Summary:** Removes language classifying facilities that perform five or more first trimester abortions per month as hospitals for the purpose of complying with regulations establishing minimum standards for hospitals.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Minimal; see item 8.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** This bill would not have a fiscal impact on the Commonwealth. The bill removes the hospital classification for facilities that perform five or more first trimester abortions per month, which would result in the loss of \$1,050 in fee revenue. The reduction of the 14 identified facilities that would be surveyed is not significant enough for a reduction in staff.

**11. Other Comments:** HB 1563, introduced by Delegate Kory, is a companion bill.
