**4.** Title: Waste and recycling charges; liens.

5. Summary: Waste and recycling charges; liens. Provides that certain waste and recycling charges, and any penalty and interest thereon, constitute a lien against the real property ranking on a parity with liens for unpaid taxes. The bill provides that a lien may be placed on the property in the amount of (i) up to three months of delinquent waste and recycling charges when the service is supplied to a lessee or tenant or (ii) up to the number of months of delinquent charges when the service is provided to the property owner.
