4. Title: Community services boards; preadmission screening; regional jail inmates

5. Summary: Provides that the duties of a community services board include reviewing any existing Memorandum of Understanding between the community services board and any other community services boards that serve the regional jail to ensure that such memorandum sets forth the roles and responsibilities of each community services board in the preadmission screening process, provides for communication and information sharing protocols between the community services boards, and provides for due consideration, including financial consideration, should there be disproportionate obligations on one of the community services boards. In the absence of an agreement, each community services board is responsible for providing services to inmates convicted in the locality served by the community services board.
