4. Title: Virginia Employment Commission; population projections.

5. Summary: Eliminates the requirement that the Virginia Employment Commission prepare population projections for the Commonwealth for use by the General Assembly and certain state agencies.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that the bill will not have a state fiscal impact. Based on current language and funding in the Appropriation Act and SB900, as introduced, the Department of Planning and Budget (DPB) has \$150,000, from the general fund, in each year of the current biennium to contract for population projections; the Virginia Employment Commission (VEC) does not have a specific appropriation for this function. Consequently, VEC does not currently develop or publish population projections.
