8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. § 1. That the Department of Health shall review consumer complaints regarding radon testing and
10	mitigation received since 2013 and the current certification requirements for individuals performing
11	radon testing and mitigation and shall determine the benefits of any additional oversight for individuals
<b>12</b>	performing radon testing and mitigation. The Department of Health shall report its findings and any
13	recommendations to the House Committee on Health, Welfare and Institutions and the Senate Committee
14	on Education and Health by December 1, 2018.
