12	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 23.1-401.1 as follows:

14	A. Except as otherwise permitted by the First Amendment to the United States Constitution, no public
<b>15</b>	institution of higher education shall abridge the constitutional freedom of any individual, including
16	enrolled students, faculty and other employees, and invited guests, to speak on campus.
<b>17</b>	B. Each public institution of higher education shall establish and include in its student handbook, on
18	its website, and in its student orientation programs policies regarding free speech on campus.
19	C. Each public institution of higher education shall develop training materials and implement
20	training programs on the policies established pursuant to subsection B for any employee who is
21	responsible for the discipline or education of enrolled students.
<b>22</b>	D. Each public institution of higher education shall post conspicuously on its website and annually
23	
23	update a report that includes:

D. Each public institution of higher education shall post conspicuously on its website and annually update a report that includes: 1. A description of any barriers to free speech on campus; any incidents of disruption of free speech

on campus, including any attempt to block or prohibit campus speakers and any investigation of students or student organizations for their speech; and any disciplinary action taken against the individual or entity that was responsible for any such barrier or incident of disruption;

2. A copy of any complaint against the institution alleging a violation of the First Amendment to the United States Constitution; and

3. Any other information relating to free speech on campus that the institution deems necessary to publicly report.

2. That § 23.1-900.1 of the Code of Virginia is repealed.
