234567 A BILL to direct the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services to implement a pilot program to evaluate the recovery community organization model of substance abuse treatment. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 8

9 1. § 1. That the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services (Department) shall 10 develop a pilot program to study implementation of a recovery community organization model of substance abuse treatment, which may include same day admission to sober housing, medical 11 detoxification services, social model recovery programs including peer-to-peer recovery support services, 12 and linkages to other treatment services, to evaluate the impacts of such programs on rates of substance 13 14 abuse, overdose, and overdose deaths; interaction with law enforcement, the judicial system, and the 15 criminal justice system; and rates of recidivism. Such pilot may be implemented in at least one location in the Commonwealth and shall be designed with input from and in consultation and collaboration with 16 representatives of recovery community substance abuse treatment services providers. The Department 17 18 shall report annually by December 1 of each year to the Governor and the General Assembly regarding development and implementation of the pilot program and outcomes of the pilot program. Following the 19 20 conclusion of the pilot program, the Department shall report to the Governor and the General Assembly 21 on (i) the outcomes of the pilot program and (ii) any recommendations for the licensure of substance 22 abuse treatment programs that integrate recovery community organizations, which recommendations

23 shall be based upon the outcome of the pilot program.
