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10	WHEREAS, the United States has long cherished its identity as a melting pot composed of
11	individuals of different races, ethnicities, cultures, religions, and genders; and
12 13	WHEREAS, it has been a tradition of the Commonwealth to embrace and appreciate diversity and to honor the rights of all Virginians, regardless of their race, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, gender,
13	or gender identity; and
15	WHEREAS, in recent years, the United States has experienced an increase in the bullying and
16	harassment of its LGBTQ youth based on their sexual orientations and gender identities, which has led
17	to, among other things, heightened rates of emotional distress, depression, low self-esteem, and suicide
18	among LGBTQ youth; and
19	WHEREAS, such intolerance and discrimination, based on ignorance, weakens the young people of
20	the Commonwealth and the state as a whole; and
21 22	WHEREAS, the continued success of the United States and the Commonwealth requires acceptance
22	of diversity among its citizens; and
23	WHEREAS, youth in the Commonwealth should feel safe in their communities and be able to fully participate in all activities without fear of being bullied, harassed, or intimidated because of their sexual
24 25	orientation or gender identity; and
26 26	WHEREAS, the Commonwealth must take measures to protect its vulnerable youth population,
27	particularly in its public schools, and to ensure that such youth receive adequate protection from
28	bullying, harassment, discrimination, and intimidation based on their sexual orientation or gender
29	identity; now, therefore, be it
30	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the Department of Education be
31	requested to study bullying and suicide prevention among LGBTQ and other youth.
32	In conducting its study, the Department of Education shall (i) assess the effectiveness of current
33	suicide prevention strategies and anti-bullying policies and codes of student conduct among school
34	divisions, including bullying by electronic means; (ii) identify areas for improvement among such
35 36	strategies, policies, and codes of conduct; (iii) determine the suicide rate of youth in the Commonwealth and identify the percentage of LGBTQ youth in such rate; and (iv) recommend strategies, policies, and
37	programs that can be used to decrease and prevent bullying, harassment, discrimination, and intimidation
38	of LGBTQ and other youth, and the rate of suicide resulting therefrom, in the Commonwealth's public
39	schools.
40	All agencies of the Commonwealth shall provide assistance to the Department of Education for this
41	study, upon request.
42	The Department of Education shall complete its meetings by November 30, 2018, and shall submit to
43	the Governor and the General Assembly an executive summary and a report of its findings and
44 47	recommendations for publication as a House or Senate document. The executive summary and report
45	shall be submitted as provided in the procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for
46 17	the processing of legislative documents and reports no later than the first day of the 2019 Regular Session of the General Assembly and shall be posted on the General Assembly's website
