SENATE BILL NO. 193 Offered January 10, 2018

A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding in Article 1 of Chapter 9 of Title 15.2 a section numbered 15.2-926.4, relating to disposable plastic shopping bags; local option.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Article 1 of Chapter 9 of Title 15.2 a section numbered 15.2-926.4 as follows:

§ 15.2-926.4. Optional ban on providing disposable plastic shopping bags.

Any locality may by ordinance prohibit the distribution, sale, and offer for sale of disposable plastic shopping bags to consumers. No prohibition adopted under the authority of this section shall apply to plastic bags that are (i) specifically designed and manufactured for multiple reuse, exhibiting durable construction, a thickness of at least 2.25 mils, and a pair of handles; (ii) used to carry alcoholic beverages, prescription drugs, ice cream, meat, fish, poultry, leftover restaurant food, newspapers, or dry cleaning; or (iii) packaged and sold in multiples for use in carrying or holding garbage, pet waste, or leaves.
