6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 18.2-308.5:1, relating to a
7	prohibition against trigger activators designed to increase the rate of fire of firearms; penalty.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-308.5:1 as follows:
10	§ 18.2-308.5:1. Sale or possession of trigger activators designed to increase rate of fire of firearms;
11	penalty.
12	A. It is unlawful for any person to manufacture, import, sell, offer for sale, possess, transfer, or
13	transport in the Commonwealth a trigger activator, including a trigger crank or a bump-fire device, that
14	is designed to increase the rate of fire of a semiautomatic rifle but does not convert the semiautomatic
15	rifle into a machine gun

ffer for sale, possess, transfer, or er crank or a bump-fire device, that does not convert the semiautomatic

B. A violation of this section shall be punishable as a Class 1 misdemeanor.

2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is \$0 for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and cannot be determined for periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
