2 *An Act to establish standards for the display of the Honor and Remember Flag at state buildings and*
3 *facilities outside of Capitol Square.*

6 Whereas, in 2010 the General Assembly designated the Honor and Remember Flag as the
7 Commonwealth's emblem of the service and sacrifice of the brave men and women of the United States
8 Armed Forces who had given their lives in the line of duty; and

9 Whereas, since that designation there have been instances where the appropriateness for the display
10 of the Honor and Remember Flag was unclear; and

11 Whereas, there is a need to clarify when it is appropriate to display the Honor and Remember Flag
12 in light of its symbolic importance; now, therefore,

13 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

14 1. § 1. *That in the absence of a directive from the Governor or the Director of the Department of*
15 *General Services, the head of the state agency that controls any facility or building outside of Capitol*
16 *Square may determine when to display the Honor and Remember Flag, provided that the Honor and*
17 *Remember Flag that is displayed is (i) smaller in height and width than the flag of the United States*
18 *that is officially displayed at the building or facility and (ii) made in the United States.*
