5 6 WHEREAS, Bill Blackburn, an active Alexandria community member and restaurateur, was named 7 the 2017 Business Leader of the Year by the Alexandria Chamber of Commerce; and

8 WHEREAS, a native of St. Louis, Missouri, Bill Blackburn graduated from the George Washington University in 2000 with a degree in business administration and quickly became involved in the 9 10 Alexandria restaurant business; and

WHEREAS, since 2001, Bill Blackburn has been a member of the Del Ray-based Home Grown 11 Restaurant Group, which employs over 100 people; and 12

WHEREAS, as managing partner with the Home Grown Restaurant Group, Bill Blackburn oversees the restaurants, Pork Barrel BBQ, Holy Cow, the Sushi Bar, and Sweet Fire Donna's; another restaurant, 13 14 15 Whiskey Oyster, will soon be opened in Alexandria's Carlyle neighborhood; and

16 WHEREAS, in addition to his work with the Home Grown Restaurant Group, Bill Blackburn is a former two-term president of the Del Ray Business Association and currently serves as a board member 17 of the Alexandria Small Business Development Center; and 18

19 WHEREAS, a dedicated community member, Bill Blackburn serves on the board of directors for the 20 Advocates for Alexandria Aquatics and has helped organize numerous local events, including the annual Turkey Trot, the Del Ray Halloween Parade, and Art on the Avenue, which draws over 20,000 people 21 22 to the City of Alexandria; and

WHEREAS, Bill Blackburn's other philanthropic endeavors include the "Holy Cow Burger Fund," 23 24 which donates 25 cents from every burger sold at Holy Cow restaurant to charity; to date, the fund has 25 contributed almost \$100,000 to over 150 nonprofit organizations that support education, assistance for 26 the homeless, animal welfare, and arts and culture; and

27 WHEREAS, by following the guiding mantra "do what you say you're going to do," Bill Blackburn 28 has provided valuable service to Alexandria and won the abiding respect of community members and 29 colleagues: now, therefore, be it

30 RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly hereby 31 commend Bill Blackburn for being named the 2017 Business Leader of the Year by the Alexandria 32 Chamber of Commerce; and, be it

33 RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the Senate prepare a copy of this resolution for presentation to Bill Blackburn as an expression of the General Assembly's admiration for his impressive 34 35 business accomplishments and ongoing commitment to the Alexandria community.
