AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE

(Proposed by the Senate Committee on Rules on February 9, 2018)

234567 Reconstituting the Virginia Women's Monument Commission and coordinating the dedication of the Virginia Women's Monument.

8 WHEREAS, Senate Joint Resolution No. 11 (2010) established a commemorative commission to 9 honor the contributions of the women of Virginia with a monument on the grounds of Capitol Square, 10 now known as the Virginia Women's Monument Commission, and Senate Joint Resolution No. 76 (2014) increased the membership of the Commission; now, therefore, be it 11

RESOLVED, by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the membership of the Virginia 12 Women's Monument Commission be reconstituted. The Commission shall consist of 20 members as 13 follows: the Governor of Virginia or his designee; the Chair of the Senate Committee on Rules; one 14 15 member of the Senate appointed by the Senate Committee on Rules; the Speaker of the House of 16 Delegates or his designee; one member of the House of Delegates at large appointed by the Speaker of the House of Delegates; the Clerk of the Senate; the Clerk of the House of Delegates; eight 17 nonlegislative citizen members of whom three members shall be appointed by the Governor, two shall 18 be appointed by the Senate Committee on Rules, and three shall be appointed by the Speaker of the 19 20 House of Delegates; and the Secretary of Administration or her designee, the immediate past Secretary 21 of Administration, the Librarian of Virginia or her designee, the Executive Director of the Virginia 22 Capitol Foundation/Chief Administrative Officer of the Capitol Square Preservation Council, and the 23 Architectural Historian of the Capitol Square Preservation Council, all of whom shall serve ex officio 24 with voting privileges; and, be it

25 RESOLVED FURTHER, That the dedication of the Virginia Women's Monument shall be coordinated by the Clerk of the Senate, the Clerk of the House of Delegates, and the Secretary of 26 27 Administration or her designee; and, be it

28 RESOLVED FINALLY, That the Governor or his designee shall serve as Chair with voting 29 privileges.

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
