**3. Committee:** Transportation

**4. Title:** Delegate Lacey Putney Memorial Highway.

**5. Summary:** Designates the portion of U.S. Route 221 between the Town of Bedford and the City of Lynchburg the "Delegate Lacey Putney Memorial Highway." The bill contains an emergency clause.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Preliminary. See Item 8.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** This legislation has no general fund impact. The Code of Virginia section 33.2-213 requires the local government to pay for the cost of the naming. The County of Bedford has agreed to pay for the cost of the signage associated with the designation. According to the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), the maximum anticipated cost of the signage is expected to be \$4,600.
