4. Title: Blind or vision impaired; rehabilitative manufacturing and service industries; sales of goods

5. Summary: The proposed legislation updates terminology regarding manufacturing and service industries operated by the Department for the Blind and Vision Impaired for the employment of individuals who are blind or vision impaired. The bill also adds language stating violating existing prohibitions associated with identification of goods as being made by the blind would be punishable by a misdemeanor.
