All candidates, regardless of political party affiliation, are on a single ballot. The two candidates receiving the highest and next highest number of votes are the candidates for that office at the general election. The political parties may not nominate candidates for these offices by any nominating method, but they are permitted to otherwise contribute to, endorse or support a candidate for these offices.
