**4. Title:** Licensure of facilities operated by agencies of the Commonwealth.

**5. Summary:** Provides for licensure of assisted living facilities, adult day care centers, and child welfare agencies operated by the agencies of the Commonwealth.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** This bill does not have a fiscal impact. The legislation provides an appeal process for enforcement actions for assisted living facilities operated by agencies of the Commonwealth. Additionally, it defines procedures that must be followed before a summary order of suspension can take effect. The Department of Social Services (DSS) is aware of two adult programs that would be affected by this legislation. While this legislation will expand the Department's legal authority, any increase in workload resulting from this bill can be absorbed within current appropriation and staffing levels and any revenue impact for DSS would be negligible.
