5. Summary: The proposed bill increases the maximum allowable spirit sample size for agents of the Board and manufacturers from one-half ounce to one ounce per single sample. The bill also increases the maximum allowable spirit content of a mixed beverage sample from one and one-half ounces to two ounces.
