**4. Title:** Military surplus off-road motor vehicles; registration and operation on highways

**5. Summary:** This bill authorizes the Department of Motor Vehicles to issue a registration card and license plates for military surplus motor vehicles, as defined in the bill. The bill authorizes the use of military surplus motor vehicles for purposes similar to those authorized for antique motor vehicles. The bill establishes a process whereby such vehicles that meet certain standards can be used for general transportation purposes. Such vehicles registered under any other Code provisions prior to January 1, 2019, may continue to be registered under such provision. The bill exempts military surplus motor vehicles from emissions standards.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) will incur minor costs for information systems programming to implement the bill. The costs will be in part offset by the \$100 fee the bill authorizes DMV to charge for permanent military surplus motor vehicle plates.

Violations of § 46.2-730.1 are subject to a Class 4 misdemeanor. A person convicted of a Class 4 misdemeanor is subject to a fine of no more than \$250, which will be deposited to the Literary Fund. The amount of revenue that might be collected is indeterminate.
