4. Title: Trooper Michael Walter Memorial Highway.

5. Summary: Designates the portion of Virginia Route 13 in Powhatan County between Virginia Route 1002 (Emmanuel Church Road) and Cumberland County the "Trooper Michael Walter Memorial Highway."

8. Fiscal Implications: Code of Virginia Section 33.2-213 requires the local government to pay for the cost of the signage of a naming. On January 22, 2018, the County of Powhatan will be voting on a supporting resolution whereby the County would agree to pay for the cost (up to \$2,000) of the signage associated with the designation. The anticipated cost of the signage is expected to be approximately \$1,700.
