**5. Summary:** Allows a Virginia resident or domiciliary to submit an application for a new concealed weapon permit via U.S. mail. Currently, new applicants must apply in person, and only renewals for previously issued permits may be submitted via mail.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The Department of State Police (VSP) processes concealed weapons applications, and such applications are submitted to the Circuit Courts for processing. There is no anticipated fiscal impact on either VSP or the courts.
