4. Title: Requires public institutions of higher education to annually conduct a test of emergency management plan

5. Summary: The proposed legislation requires each public institution of higher education to annually conduct a test or exercise in accordance with the protocols established by the institution's crisis and emergency management plan and certify in writing to the Department of Emergency Management that such a test or exercise was conducted.

Under current law, each such institution is required to annually conduct a functional exercise in accordance with the protocols of such plan. The bill declares that an actual incident or event that results in the activation of the plan and the completion and submission of an after action report shall meet the requirement to conduct and certify such a test or exercise.
