4. Title: Safety inspection stickers; placement on motorcycles.

5. Summary: Provides that the owner of a motorcycle that is issued a safety inspection approval sticker will have the option of either displaying the sticker on a plate that is securely fastened to the motorcycle or affixing it to the motorcycle directly. The bill directs the Superintendent of State Police to designate the location on motorcycles where plates will be fastened or where stickers will be affixed.
