3. Committee: Passed Both Houses

4. Title: Child abuse and neglect; founded reports regarding former school employees.

5. Summary: Requires local departments of social services to notify the appropriate school board without delay if the subject of a founded complaint of child abuse or neglect was, at the time of the investigation or the conduct that led to the report, an employee of a school division located within the Commonwealth. Currently, such reporting is only required if the subject of the complaint is an employee of a school division at the time the complaint is determined to be founded.

8. Fiscal Implications: No fiscal impact is anticipated. This bill ensures that a local school board is made aware of a founded complaint of child abuse or neglect in call cases where the conduct occurred while the subject was an employee of the local school board, regardless of whether or not the employee continued his/her employment throughout the investigation.
