Elections to provide general registrars voter confirmation documents for newly registered voters and notice to registered voters on the system changes and corrections in their registration records and polling places. The number of voters that may be affected by this bill cannot be determined.

The proposed legislation should not have a material fiscal impact on the Department of Elections. The additional costs the agency may incur include updating instructions and guidance documents to include translation, and, if needed, changes to the Virginia Election and Registration Information System (VERIS), changes to web materials, printing and distribution of forms, additional support for staff to research Code sections and update forms impacted by the legislation, and training to assure officers of election and voters are aware of any changes.

This legislation is not expected to have a fiscal impact on the Division of Legislative Services.
